MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

150 Provisions as to exemptions, &c.

- (1) Any power conferred by this Act or regulations [^{F1} or health and safety regulations which expressly apply to all mines, any class of mine or a particular mine] on [^{F2} the Executive] or an inspector to grant, give or impose an exemption, consent, approval, authority, direction, requirement, prohibition or restriction or to make a determination shall be construed as including a power exercisable in the like manner and subject to the like conditions, if any, to vary or revoke the exemption, consent, approval, authority, direction, requirement, prohibition, restriction or determination.
- (2) Any exemption, consent, approval or authority granted or given under this Act or regulations [^{F1} or such health and safety regulations] by [^{F2} the Executive], or by an inspector exercising any function conferred on him under section 120(3), may (subject to any express provision of this Act or regulations [^{F1} or such health and safety regulations]) be without limit of period or limited so as to expire on a specified date unless renewed, and may be absolute or conditional.
