



# Mines Act (Northern Ireland) 1969

## 1969 CHAPTER 6

### PART III

#### SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE

#### LIGHTING, LAMPS AND CONTRABAND

**64 Prohibition of taking into mines safety-lamps not provided by owner or of approved type.**

- (1) No person shall take or use below ground in a mine a safety-lamp other than one provided by the owner of the mine.
- (2) No person shall take or use below ground in a mine a safety-lamp other than one<sup>F1</sup> conforming with the provisions of regulation 19(2)(a) to (d) of the Electricity at Work Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1991 or] of a type for the time being approved by<sup>F2</sup> the Executive]
  - (a) for use in mines generally, in mines of a class to which that mine belongs or in that mine; and
  - (b) for use by all persons or persons of a class to which that person belongs.
