##### CONTRACTS

#### **100 Sealing of contracts**

- (1) Any contract or instrument which if made or executed by a person not being a body corporate would not be required to be made<sup>[F1]</sup> by deed] may, if made by a council and if the subject matter thereof<sup>[F2]</sup> does not exceed £30,000 in value], be made or executed on behalf of the council by any person or persons generally or specially authorised by the council to act for that purpose.

[<sup>F2</sup>(1A) The Department may by order amend subsection (1) so as to increase the amount for the time being specified in that subsection.]

- (2) Nothing in this section shall be taken as preventing any contract or instrument from being made or executed by a council under its common seal.
