ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

123 Penalty for destroying notices.

- ^{F1} A person who wilfully destroys, tampers with, pulls down, injures or defaces—
- (a) any board on or to which any bye-law, notice or other matter put up by the authority of the Ministry or of a council is inscribed or affixed; or
 - (b) any advertisement, placard, bill or notice put up by or under the direction of a council;

shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding^{F2} level 3 on the standard scale].
