BYE-LAWS

^{F1}93 Enforcement of bye-laws.

- (1) An officer of a council who is authorised by the council in that behalf^{F2} or a constable], may secure the observance of bye-laws made by the council.
- (2) An officer exercising powers conferred under this section, unless in uniform, shall, on request, produce some document showing that he is authorised by the council to exercise those powers.
- (3) For the purposes of this section,^{F3} section 66 of the Police (Northern Ireland) Act 1998] (assault on, and obstruction of, constables, etc.) shall have effect in relation to a person authorised as mentioned in subsection (1) as if he were a constable.
