PROVISIONS COMMON TO COMMISSION AND COUNCIL

Grants and guarantees

60 Grants

- (1) The Scottish Ministers may make grants to F1... the Council towards expenses incurred, or to be incurred, by it in connection with—
 - (a) the initial establishment of the [F2Council]; and
 - (b) the discharge by [F3the Council] of its functions.
- (2) Any grant made under subsection (1) above may be made on such terms and subject to such conditions (including conditions as to repayment) as the Scottish Ministers think fit; and the Scottish Ministers may from time to time after the grant is made vary such terms and conditions.
