Duty to consult

Duty of Commission and Council to consult each other

The ^{F1}... Council shall ^{F2}..., in the exercise of its functions, consult [F3Social Care and Social Work Improvement Scotland] in every case in which it appears to the [F4Council] appropriate that there should be such consultation.
