  - (d) in respect of any article which is recovered or preserved from the effects of an attachment which, by virtue of—
    - (i) section 11(1) of that Act of 2002; or
    - (ii) the article not being a non-essential asset for the purposes of Part 3 of that Act,

is incompetent.".
