



# Water Industry (Scotland) Act 2002

### PART 1

#### WATER INDUSTRY COMMISSIONER AND CUSTOMER PANELS

#### [<sup>F1</sup>6C Co-operation between the Commission and Customer Panels

- (1) The Commission and the Convener (as appropriate, representing the Customer Panels as a whole) must together make arrangements with a view to securing—
  - (a) co-operation and the exchange of information—
    - (i) between the Commission and Customer Panels,
    - (ii) between the Commission and the Convener, and
  - (b) the consistent treatment of matters which affect—
    - (i) both the Commission and Customer Panels,
    - (ii) both the Commission and the Convener.
- (2) The Commission and the Convener—
  - (a) must set out the arrangements in a memorandum,
  - (b) must keep the arrangements under review, and
  - (c) may from time to time revise the arrangements.
- (3) A copy of the memorandum, and of any revised memorandum, must be sent jointly by the Commission and the Convener to the Scottish Ministers.]
