## SCHEDULE 1 THE MENTAL WELFARE COMMISSION FOR SCOTLAND

### PART 1

#### MEMBERSHIP, PROCEEDINGS ETC.

#### *Appointment etc. of chief [F1 executive] and other staff*

- 7 (1) Subject to sub-paragraphs (2) and (3) below [F2 and paragraph 10A], the Commission—
- (a) shall appoint a chief [F3 executive ]; and
  - (b) may appoint such other staff as it considers appropriate, on such terms and conditions as it may, with the approval of the Scottish Ministers, determine.
- (2) A member of the Commission may not be appointed as a member of its staff.
- (3) The Commission shall obtain the approval of the Scottish Ministers before appointing a chief [F4 executive].
- (4) The Commission may pay to the members of its staff, including its chief [F5 executive], (referred to in this paragraph collectively as “employees”) such remuneration and allowances as the Scottish Ministers may determine.
- (5) The Commission may—
- (a) pay, or make arrangements for the payment of;
  - (b) make payments towards the provision of; and
  - (c) provide and maintain schemes (whether contributory or not) for the payment of,
- such pensions, allowances and gratuities to or in respect of such of its employees, or former employees, as the Scottish Ministers may determine.
- (6) The reference in sub-paragraph (5) above to pensions, allowances and gratuities includes a reference to pensions, allowances and gratuities by way of compensation for loss of employment or reduction in remuneration.
- (7) A determination under sub-paragraph (4) or (5) above may make different provision for different cases or descriptions of case.
