## THE MENTAL WELFARE COMMISSION FOR SCOTLAND

### Particular functions

### 16 Inspection etc. of records

- (1) A person authorised by the Commission (an "authorised person") [<sup>F1</sup>or Commission Visitor] may, in connection with the discharge by the Commission of any of its functions under—
  - (a) this Act; or
  - (b) the Adults with Incapacity (Scotland) Act 2000 (asp 4),

require any person holding medical or other records of a patient to produce them for inspection by the authorised person [<sup>F2</sup>or, as the case may be, the Commission Visitor].

- (2) An authorised person shall be-
  - <sup>F3</sup>(a) .....
    - (b) a member of the staff of the Commission.
- (3) An authorised person proposing to exercise the power conferred by subsection (1) above shall, if requested to do so, produce an authenticated document showing that the authorised person is <sup>F4</sup>... a member of staff of the Commission.
