##### *General duties*

#### 5 Duty to monitor operation of Act and promote best practice

The Commission shall—

- (a) monitor the [<sup>F1</sup>practical application of the observance of Part 1] of this Act; and
- (b) promote best practice in relation to the [<sup>F2</sup>practical application of the observance of Part 1 of this Act].
