Functions

## 8 Initiation and conduct of investigation

- (1) Before taking any steps in the conduct of an investigation, the Commissioner must-
  - (a) draw up terms of reference for the investigation; and
  - [<sup>F1</sup>(b) take such steps as appear to the Commissioner to be appropriate with a view to bringing notice of the investigation and terms of reference to the attention of persons likely to be affected by it.]
- (2) [<sup>F2</sup>A general] investigation is to be conducted in public except to the extent that the Commissioner considers that the taking of evidence in private is necessary or appropriate.
- [<sup>F3</sup>(3) An individual investigation is to be conducted in private.]
