**Enactment****Extent of repeal**

Education (Scotland) Act 1980 (c. 44)

In section 98, in subsection (1), the words from “and”, where it second occurs, to the end; subsections (1A) and (3)(c).  
In section 99(1), the words “or provisionally registered”.  
In section 101, in subsection (3), the words from “or”, where it first occurs, to “school” where it second occurs and the words “or from being so employed”; in subsection (4), the words “shall be deemed to be so disqualified”.  
In section 102(1), the words “Part V of the Act of 1946, Part V of the Act of 1962 or”.  
In section 135(1), the definition of “provisionally registered school”; in the definition of “registered school” the words “is final”.
