#### **OFFENCES**

Drunkenness and disorderly conduct

## 114 Premises manager, staff etc. not to be drunk

- (1) Any responsible person in relation to any relevant premises who is drunk while on the premises commits an offence.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
