4 The licensing objectives

- (1) For the purposes of this Act, the licensing objectives are—
 - (a) preventing crime and disorder,
 - (b) securing public safety,
 - (c) preventing public nuisance,
 - (d) protecting and improving public health, and
 - (e) protecting children from harm.
