80 Inquiries

The Scottish Ministers may cause an inquiry to be held into—

- (a) the manner in which [^{F1}SFRS] is carrying out any of its functions under this Act;
- (b) the circumstances of, or the steps taken to deal with—
 - (i) a fire;
 - (ii) a road traffic accident; or
 - (iii) an emergency of another kind in relation to which [^{F2}SFRS] has functions under this Act.
