# 81 Inquiries: supplementary

- (1) The Scottish Ministers may by regulations make provision in connection with inquiries under this Act.
- (2) The reference in subsection (1) to inquiries does not include inquiries mentioned in section [FI43B].
- (3) Regulations under subsection (1) may in particular make provision for or in connection with—
  - (a) the persons who may conduct an inquiry and their appointment to do so;
  - (b) the giving of notice of an inquiry;
  - (c) requiring persons to attend an inquiry—
    - (i) to give evidence; or
    - (ii) to produce documents;
  - (d) the taking of evidence on oath;
  - (e) the payment of expenses—
    - (i) of witnesses; and
    - (ii) of or concerning the production of documents;
  - (f) the making of awards of expenses in respect of—
    - (i) an inquiry; or
    - (ii) arrangements made for an inquiry which does not take place;
  - (g) what expenses may be included in such awards;
  - (h) how expenses are to be calculated; and
  - (i) recovery of expenses.
