Section 21: Short title and commencement

The Schedule: Registrable financial interests Sponsorship

88. Paragraph 5 makes provision for sponsorship to be a registrable interest. Subparagraph (2) provides that a member is sponsored by receiving, or having received any financial or material support as a member from the same person on more than one occasion which over a parliamentary session amounts in aggregate to more than a specified limit. Services provided by a volunteer are excepted from this definition. "Specified limit" is detailed in sub-paragraph (3) as 1 per cent of a member's salary as published at the beginning of the parliamentary session (currently £480).
