## SCHEDULE 1 SCOTTISH COMMISSION FOR HUMAN RIGHTS

## General powers

- 8 (1) The Commission may do anything which appears necessary or expedient for the purpose of, or in connection with, or which appears conducive to, the exercise of its functions.
