MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

44 Application of Crichton Down Rules

- (1) The authorised undertaker shall apply the Crichton Down Rules in relation to surplus land.
- (2) In this section—
 - “the Crichton Down Rules” means the rules set out in the Scottish Development Department Circular 38 of 1992 (“Disposal of Surplus Government Land – the Crichton Down Rules”) as amended or superseded from time to time;
 - “surplus land” means any land acquired compulsorily under section 12 which is subsequently declared by the authorised undertaker to be surplus to the authorised undertaker's requirements for the provision of the authorised works.

Changes to legislation:
