MISCELLANEOUS AND GENERAL

General provisions

60 Interpretation

- (1) In this Act—
 - "mental disorder" has the meaning given by section 17(3), "penis" and "vagina" have the meanings given by section 1(4).
- (2) For the purposes of this Act—
 - (a) penetration, touching, or any other activity,
 - (b) a communication,
 - (c) a manner of exposure, or
 - (d) a relationship,

is sexual if a reasonable person would, in all the circumstances of the case, consider it to be sexual.
