CHILD ASSESSMENT AND CHILD PROTECTION ORDERS

Offences

59 Offences

- (1) A person who intentionally obstructs—
 - (a) a person acting under a child assessment order,
 - (b) a person acting under a child protection order,
 - (c) a person acting under an order under section 55, or
 - (d) a constable acting under section 56(1),

commits an offence.

(2) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
