### *Criminal Justice and Licensing (Scotland) Act 2010*

- 27 In section 153 (appeals), in subsection (10)—
- (a) for the definition of “accused” substitute—
    - ““accused” includes—
    - (a) appellant or, where the order relates to section 136(2), 137(2) or 138(2), other person to whom the section concerned applies, and
    - (b) respondent,”
  - (b) after the definition of “appellant” insert—
    - ““respondent” has the meaning given by section 140A.”.
