The cadastral map

13 The cadastral map: further provision

- (1) Where a plot of land—
 - (a) lies wholly outwith the base map, or
 - (b) extends partly outwith the base map,the Keeper may adopt such means of representing the boundaries on the cadastral map as the Keeper considers appropriate.
- (2) The Keeper may—
 - (a) combine cadastral units,
 - (b) remove a cadastral unit from the map, or
 - (c) divide a cadastral unit.
- (3) On dividing a cadastral unit under subsection (2)(c), the Keeper may combine any of the resultant parts with a different cadastral unit.
- (4) The Keeper must make such changes to the register as are necessary in consequence of anything done under subsections (2) and (3).
