GENERAL

Interpretation

42 General interpretation

- (1) In this Act—
 - "award notice" has the meaning given in section 23(6),
 - "community benefit requirement" has the meaning given in section 24,
 - "contract notice" has the meaning given in section 23(6),
 - "contracting authority" has the meaning given in section 1,
 - "economic operator" means any person who offers the execution of works, the supply of products or the provision of services on the market,
 - "financial year" means the period of 12 months in respect of which the accounts of the contracting authority in question are prepared,
 - "public contract" [FImeans a contract for pecuniary interest concluded in writing between one or more economic operators and one or more contracting authorities and having as its object the execution of works, the supply of products or the provision of services]
 - "Public Contracts website" has the meaning given in section 22,
 - "public works contract" [F2means a public contract having as its object one of the following—
 - (a) the execution or the design and execution of works related to one of the activities within the meaning of schedule 2 of the Public Contracts Regulations,
 - (b) the execution or the design and execution of a work,
 - (c) the realisation, by whatever means, of a work corresponding to the requirements specified by the contracting authority exercising a decisive influence on the type or design of the work,
 - (except in a subsidised public works contract),]

[&]quot;regulated procurement" has the meaning given in section 2.
