HISTORIC ENVIRONMENT SCOTLAND ACT 2014

EXPLANATORY NOTES

STRUCTURE OF THE ACT

8. The Act is in seven Parts:
 - Part 1 - Historic Environment Scotland;
 - Part 2 - Functions in relation to scheduled monuments;
 - Part 3 - Functions in relation to listing and conservation;
 - Part 4 - Functions in relation to the marine environment;
 - Part 5 - Dissolution of RCAHMS and transfer of staff etc. to Historic Environment Scotland;
 - Part 6 - Further modifications in relation to the historic environment; and
 - Part 7 – Final provisions.
9. The Act also includes six schedules setting out the detailed arrangements in relation to a number of areas covered by the Act and making minor and consequential amendments.
