STRATEGY AND REPORTING

37 Duty to co-operate on strategy

- (1) A specified Scottish public authority must—
 - (a) provide such information and assistance to the Scottish Ministers as they may reasonably require, and
 - (b) otherwise co-operate with the Scottish Ministers,in the preparation of the strategy under section 35 and the review of the strategy under section 36.
- (2) The Scottish Ministers may by regulations specify a Scottish public authority for the purposes of subsection (1).
