Government and Parliament communications etc.

- 22 A communication made by or on behalf of—
- (a) a member of the Scottish Parliament,
 - (b) the Scottish Ministers or other office-holder in the Scottish Administration,
 - (c) a local authority,
 - (d) any other Scottish public authority within the meaning of the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002,
 - (e) a member of the House of Commons,
 - (f) a member of the House of Lords,
 - (g) Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom,
 - (h) a member of the National Assembly for Wales,
 - (i) the Welsh Assembly Government,
 - (j) a member of the Northern Ireland Assembly,
 - (k) the First Minister of Northern Ireland, the deputy First Minister of Northern Ireland, the Northern Ireland Ministers or any Northern Ireland department,
 - (l) any other public authority within the meaning of the Freedom of Information Act 2000,
 - (m) a State other than the United Kingdom,
 - (n) an institution of the European Union,
 - (o) an international organisation.
