MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

71 First-tier Tribunal's jurisdiction

(1) In relation to civil proceedings arising from a private residential tenancy—

- (a) the First-tier Tribunal has whatever competence and jurisdiction a sheriff would have but for paragraph (b),
- (b) a sheriff does not have competence or jurisdiction.

(2) For the purposes of subsection (1), civil proceedings are any proceedings other than—

- (a) the prosecution of a criminal offence,
- (b) any proceedings related to such a prosecution.
