SPECIAL RULES FOR TERMINAL ILLNESS CASES

No requirement for assessment

- 10 The regulations may not make the eligibility of an individual who has a terminal illness depend on the individual producing any evidence of that fact beyond a diagnosis by [^{F1}an appropriate healthcare professional (see paragraph 1(2C))].
