## SCHEDULE 1 CONSUMER SCOTLAND

### *Authority to perform functions*

- 9 (1) Consumer Scotland may authorise—
- (a) any of its members,
  - (b) any committee or sub-committee established by it,
  - (c) its chief executive, or
  - (d) any other member of its staff,
- to perform such of its functions (and to such extent) as it determines.
- (2) But Consumer Scotland may not authorise another person to perform any of the following functions—
- (a) approving any annual budget or financial plan,
  - (b) approving annual reports or accounts.
- (3) The giving of authority under this paragraph to perform a function does not—
- (a) affect Consumer Scotland's responsibility for the performance of the function, or
  - (b) prevent Consumer Scotland from performing the function itself.
