- An offence committed by attempting or conspiring to commit the offence of murder or any offence listed in paragraphs 1 to 77 of this schedule.

### Superseded offences

An offence superseded (whether directly or indirectly) by any offence listed in paragraphs 1 to 79 of this schedule (and any qualification in relation to a listed offence applies to the superseded offence as it applies to the listed offence).

### Combined offences

An offence which was charged, and the conviction for which was received, in conjunction with any offence listed in paragraphs 1 to 80 of this schedule.
