FINAL PROVISIONS

44 Commencement

- (1) The following provisions come into force on the day after Royal Assent—
 - (a) section 1,
 - (b) section 26(1) to (4),
 - (c) section 29(1)(a),
 - (d) section 29(3), insofar as it relates to section 29(1)(a),
 - (e) section 30(1) to (7) and (12) to (14),
 - (f) section 31,
 - (g) section 42,
 - (h) section 43,
 - (i) this section,
 - (i) section 45.
- (2) The other provisions of this Act come into force on such day as the Scottish Ministers may by regulations appoint.
- (3) Regulations under subsection (2) may appoint different days for different purposes.
- (4) Regulations under subsection (2) may—
 - (a) include transitional, transitory or saving provision,
 - (b) make different provision for different purposes.
