##### *Time periods for responding to requests*

- 3 (1) Section 10 (time for compliance) has effect as if modified as follows—
- (a) in subsection (1), for “twentieth” there were substituted “sixtieth”,
  - (b) in subsection (2), in the closing text, for—
    - (i) “twentieth” there were substituted “sixtieth”,
    - (ii) “thirtieth” there were substituted “seventieth”,
  - (c) in subsection (3), in the closing text, for—
    - (i) “twentieth” there were substituted “sixtieth”,
    - (ii) “thirtieth” there were substituted “seventieth”.
- (2) Section 21 (review by Scottish public authority) has effect as if modified as follows—
- (a) in subsection (1), for “twentieth” there were substituted “sixtieth”,
  - (b) in subsection (2), in the closing text, for—
    - (i) “twentieth” there were substituted “sixtieth”, and
    - (ii) “thirtieth” there were substituted “seventieth”.
