

Pre-release Access to Official Statistics (Scotland) Act 2021 2021 asp 11

3 Duty to commission review

- (1) As soon as practicable after the end of the period of 3 years beginning with Royal Assent, the Scottish Ministers must commission a review of, and preparation of a report on, the impact of the reduction and removal of pre-release access to official statistics on Scotland's gross domestic product and Scottish retail sales (whether by volume or value).
- (2) The person or organisation appointed to conduct the review required under subsection (1) must be independent of the Scottish Ministers.
- (3) The Scottish Ministers must, as soon as practicable after receiving the report required under subsection (1)—
 - (a) publish the report, and
 - (b) lay a copy of the report before the Scottish Parliament.
