Commencement Information

- II** Sch. Pt. 3 comes into force in accordance with s. 47(2)

Article 7

States Parties shall, subject to the provisions of their national law:

- (a) Take measures to provide for the seizure and confiscation, as appropriate, of:
 - (i) Goods such as materials, assets and other instrumentalities used to commit or facilitate offences under the present Protocol;
 - (ii) Proceeds derived from such offences;
- (b) Execute requests from another State Party for seizure or confiscation of goods or proceeds referred to in subparagraph (a)(i);
- (c) Take measures aimed at closing, on a temporary or definitive basis, premises used to commit such offences.
