When our Lord the King giveth or granteth Land or a Manor with the Appurtenances, without he make express mention in his Deed or Writing of \ldots ^{F7}, Advowsons of Churches, \ldots ^{F7}, belonging to such Manor or Land, then at this Day the King reserveth to himself such \ldots ^{F7}, Advowsons, \ldots ^{F7}, albeit that among other Persons it hath been observed otherwise.
