1746 CHAPTER 50 20 Geo 2

10 Tenure of feu cum maritagio, &c. taken away.

And whereas there are certain lands in Scotland held by the tenure of feu cum maritagio, or with clauses de non alienando sine consensu superiorum; in all time coming, from and after the said twenty-fifth day of March, the casualty of marriage consequent upon such holding, and all such prohibitory clauses restraining the power of alienation, be taken away and discharged \dots F¹
