CHAPTER 70

INCITEMENT TO MUTINY ACT 1797 (REPEALED 19.11.1998)

Any person who shall attempt to seduce any sailor or soldier from his duty or incite him to mutiny, &c. to suffer death.
Persons tried for offences against this Act not to be tried again for the same, as high treason, or misprision of high treason, &c.
