Forgery of passport.

- (1 F1 If any personF2... makes a statement which is to his knowledge untrue for the purpose of procuring a passport whether for himself or any other person he shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable—
 - (a) on summary conviction, to imprisonment for any term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding[F3 level 3 on the standard scale] or to both such imprisonment and fine;
 - (b) on conviction on indictment, to imprisonment for any term not exceeding two years or to | F3 an unlimited fine | or to both such imprisonment and fine.
