INTERPRETATION

52 Interpretation of Part 2

In this Part, unless the context otherwise requires-

[^{F1}"Chief Inspector" has the meaning given by section 43A(6),]

[^{F1}"Chief Officer" means the person appointed under paragraph 7 of schedule 1A,] "emergency" means an event or situation that causes or is likely to cause—

- (a) a person to die;
- (b) a person to suffer serious-
 - (i) injury; or
 - (ii) illness; or
- (c) serious harm to the environment (including the life and health of plants and animals and the fabric of buildings);

"extinguishing", in relation to a fire, includes containing and controlling; [^{F1}"framework document" means the document prepared under, and having effect by virtue of, section 40,]

[^{F1}"Inspector" has the meaning given by section 43A(6),]

"road" has the same meaning as in Part 4 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (c. 22).
