78 Ancillary provision

(1) The Scottish Ministers may by order make such incidental, supplemental, consequential, transitional, transitory or saving provision as they consider necessary or expedient for the purposes, or in consequence, of, or for giving full effect to, this Act or any provision of it.

[^{F2}(1A) The Scottish Ministers may make such further provision as, having regard to the effect of the Legal Services Act 2007 so far as concerning the subject matter of Parts 1 and 2 of this Act (and applying in Scotland), they consider necessary or expedient in connection with this Act or any related provisions of the 1980 Act.]

(2) An order under this section may—

- (a) make different provision for different purposes;
- (b) modify any enactment, instrument or document.

79 Regulations or orders

- (1) Any power conferred by this Act on the Scottish Ministers to make orders or regulations—
- must be exercised by statutory instrument;
 - may be exercised so as to make different provision for different purposes.
- (2) A statutory instrument containing an order or regulations made under this Act (except an order made under section 26(1) or 82(2)) is, subject to subsection (3), subject to annulment in pursuance of a resolution of the Parliament.
- (3) A statutory instrument containing—
- an order under section 10(7) or 24(8);
 - regulations under section 41(1);
 - an order under—
 - section 78(1)^{F3} or (1A)] containing provisions which add to, replace or omit any part of the text of an Act;
 - paragraph 2(7) of schedule 1,
- is not to be made unless a draft of the instrument has been laid before, and approved by resolution of, the Parliament.
