SCHEDULE CONSEQUENTIAL MODIFICATIONS

Crofting Reform (Scotland) Act 2010 (asp 14)

- 2 (1) The 2010 Act is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 4(4) (triggers for first registration), in paragraph (l)—
- (a) omit “or” after sub-paragraph (ii),
 - (b) after that sub-paragraph insert—
“ (ia) by application under section 24A(1) of that Act;
or”.
- (3) In section 5(3) (events to be registered in relation to registered crofts), in paragraph (l), for “, as the case may be, (3)” substitute “ (3) or, as the case may be, 24B(1) ”.
- (4) In section 10 (completion of registration: further provision on first registrations)—
- (a) in subsection (7), after “(l)(ii)” insert “, (l)(ia) ”,
 - (b) in subsection (8)(b), after “(3)” insert “ or 24B(1) ”.
- (5) In section 15(3) (resumed and decrofted crofts)—
- (a) in paragraph (a), for “, as the case may be, (3)” substitute “ (3) or, as the case may be, 24B(1) ”,
 - (b) after that paragraph insert—
“ (aa) in the case of a decrofting direction under section 24B(1), the Commission have not revoked the direction under section 25(3);”.
- (6) In schedule 2 (persons responsible for registration)—
- (a) in Table 1, after the entry relating to section 4(4)(l)(ii) insert—

“The making of an application as mentioned in section 4(4)(l)(ia)	The owner-occupier crofter making the application”,

 - (b) in Table 2, in the entry relating to section 5(3)(l), in the second column, for “landlord” substitute “ person ”.
