PLEDGE

Enforcement of pledge

PROSPECTIVE

72 Secured creditor's right to protect and manage the property

- (1) A secured creditor who, by virtue of [section 68\(1\)](#), is entitled to sell property is entitled to take reasonable steps to—
- protect, maintain and manage it, and
 - preserve its value.
- (2) The right under [subsection \(1\)](#) includes, for example, the right of the secured creditor to—
- effect or maintain an insurance policy in relation to the property,
 - settle any liability in relation to the property,
 - bring, defend or continue legal proceedings in relation to the property,
 - take such other steps as the provider has agreed (whether before or after the pledge becomes enforceable by virtue of [section 64\(2\)](#)) may be taken by the secured creditor.
- (3) [Subsection \(1\)](#) is without prejudice to [section 67\(2\)\(b\)](#).
