Legal proceedings

Prosecution by inspectors

24. An inspector, if authorised in that behalf in writing by^{[F1} the Executive], may, although he is not of counsel or a solicitor, prosecute, conduct or defend before a court of summary jurisdiction any information complaint or other proceeding arising under this Order or in the discharge of his duty as inspector.
