**Police Emblems and Flags Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002**

FLAGS

**The Service Flag**

8. The design of the flag for the police is the design illustrated in Schedule 1 to these Regulations on a dark green background.

**Flying and carrying of the Service Flag and other flags**

9. Subject to regulation 10, the Service Flag is the only flag which may be flown on land or buildings used for the purposes of the police, or from a vehicle, vessel or aircraft used in connection with the police.

10.—(1) On the occasion of a visit by Her Majesty the Queen to a building used for the purposes of the police, the Royal Standard may be flown at that building.

(2) Where the building concerned has more than one flagpole, the Service Flag may also be flown, but not in a superior position to the Royal Standard.

**Parades**

11. The only flag which may be carried by the police on parade is the Service Flag.
