# Police Emblems and Flags Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2002

#### **FLAGS**

## The Service Flag

**8.** The design of the flag for the police is the design illustrated in Schedule 1 to these Regulations on a dark green background.

### Flying and carrying of the Service Flag and other flags

- **9.** Subject to regulation 10, the Service Flag is the only flag which may be flown on land or buildings used for the purposes of the police, or from a vehicle, vessel or aircraft used in connection with the police.
- **10.**—(1) On the occasion of a visit by Her Majesty the Queen to a building used for the purposes of the police, the Royal Standard may be flown at that building.
- (2) Where the building concerned has more than one flagpole, the Service Flag may also be flown, but not in a superior position to the Royal Standard.

#### **Parades**

11. The only flag which may be carried by the police on parade is the Service Flag.
