The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(1) and (2) of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985(1), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) (West Coast) (No. 2) (Scotland) Revocation Order 2001 and shall come into force at 1230 hours on 30th March 2001.

2. The Orders specified in the Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Amnesic Shellfish Poisoning) (West Coast) (No. 2) (Scotland) Order 2000 (“the principal Order”) which prohibited–

Status: This is the original version (as it was originally made). This item of legislation is currently only available in its original format.

- (a) fishing for or taking scallops within the areas designated in the Schedule to that Order (article 4 of the principal Order);
- (b) movement of such scallops out of those areas (article 5 of the principal Order); and
- (c) landing, using in the preparation or processing for supply of food of, supplying and other specified activities in relation to, such scallops from the designated areas (article 6 of the principal Order).

The principal Order had been partially revoked by [S.S.I. 2000/313, 346, 378, 404 and 435](#), and [2001/10 and 24](#) which are also revoked by this Order. The effect of this Order is to remove the remaining prohibitions in respect of the areas of sea designated in the Schedule to the principal Order.
