**The Health Protection (Coronavirus) (Requirements)
(Scotland) Revocation (No. 2) Regulations 2022**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the power conferred by paragraph 1(1) of schedule 19 of the Coronavirus Act 2020⁽¹⁾ (“the Act”) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with paragraph 6(2), (3) and (4) of schedule 19 of the Act, the Scottish Ministers are of the opinion that, by reason of urgency, it is necessary to make these Regulations without a draft having been laid before, and approved by a resolution of, the Scottish Parliament.
